How can I help my child at Key Stage 3 Maths?

- i. Practise multiplication tables at home.
- ii. Encourage your child to discuss money, best deals etc while out shopping.
- iii. Ensure your child has the correct equipment and they are organised with their homework and encourage resilience on recall areas of the fortnightly topic homework.
- iv. Be able to use an analogue clock.
- v. Use maths websites at home such [Corbett Maths](#) and [Maths Genie](#)
- vi. Encourage a positive attitude towards the subject.

How can I help my child at Key Stage 4 Maths?

- i. Help them carefully plan their revision before exams. Make sure they are answering questions and not just reading a revision book.
- ii. Ensure they have the correct equipment, especially a scientific calculator.
- iii. Discuss financial matters with them at home eg mortgages, interest rates and household budgeting.
- iv. Support their attendance at all revision sessions offered and with organisation of homework set.
