Extreme weather procedures

As we enter the time of year where more challenging weather is upon us, we are writing to remind you of the procedures we adopt in extreme weather conditions and the measures in place to keep you informed of how we will continue education through any periods where school may close due to the extreme weather conditions.

School Closure

The school will remain open in all but exceptional circumstances. Should school closure prove unavoidable due to the safety of our pupils and staff, we will do all we can to inform families as early as possible through SMS text messages, Email, the website and local radio stations.

Pupil Absence

Parents should continue to exercise their own judgement as to whether conditions in their locality make it advisable to attend school. If your son or daughter is absent from school on any day please either email: admin@reddish.stockport.sch.uk or telephone school and leave a message on the voicemail system, giving your child's name and form. Our telephone lines get extremely busy, please leave a message if it all possible rather than speak to an operator.

Weather deterioration during the school day

In the event of a sudden deterioration in weather conditions during a school day, pupils should not telephone parents to request alternative arrangements or pre-empt decision-making within school. Parents will be informed of any changes.

If school has to close early

Parents will be informed by SMS message and Email that school is closing early, pupils will be able to leave the premises unless alternative contingency plans are in place and established by agreement.

Online Learning

In the event of a school closure due to extreme weather, lessons will be set online as pupils will be able to access them via their Google Classroom account.
