

# Uniform Expectations

We have strict uniform standards and expect all pupils to wear our uniform correctly every day. Having a school uniform plays a fundamental role in promoting self-confidence and a feeling of belonging within the school community.

Uniform can be purchased from Monkhouse or Triple S. Items of school uniform can also be bought from the school's uniform shop (second hand).

The uniform consists of;

- Blazer with school logo
- Navy jumper with badge (optional)
- Reddish Vale tie
- White long/short sleeve shirt (unbranded)
- Black full length trousers, non-stretchy (Unbranded)
- Skirts with RVHS logo to be no shorter than knee-length\*
- Waterproof black coat

\*Pupils can choose to wear an unbranded black school skirt, however, it must be knee-length and non-stretchy material.



# PE kit

**All pupils are expected to wear the Reddish Vale PE kit when taking part in PE lessons.**

## **For girls, this includes:**

- RVHS skort, leggings, shorts or tracksuit bottoms
- RVHS T-shirt
- RVHS jumper (optional)
- Trainers

## **For boys, this includes:**

- RVHS shorts or tracksuit bottoms
- RVHS T-shirt
- RVHS jumper (optional)
- Navy football socks
- Trainers

**For football lessons the following is also required:**

- Football boots with moulded studs or plastic/nylon screw in studs. No metal studs/blades, no trainers and no flat shoes are to be worn during football lessons
- Shin pads
- Navy football socks

**Pupils must remember their correct Reddish Vale PE kit for every lesson.**



# Footwear



Footwear must consist of plain black shoes. Canvas shoes, trainers, boots or shoes with logos are not permitted.

Pupils who do not attend school in the correct uniform may be offered a replacement item to borrow for the day if we have one available.

If this is not possible, parents will be asked to bring the correct item into school. Should pupils not wear the correct uniform, they may be isolated until the issue is rectified.

Our uniform has to be worn by all pupils, and we would request that every item of school clothing is clearly labelled with your child's name.

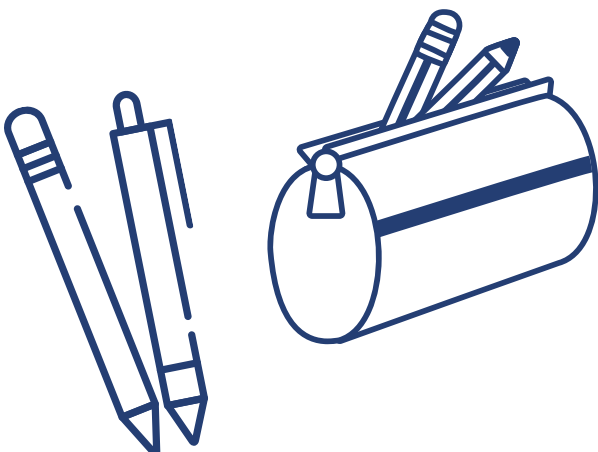
# Equipment and Non Negotiables

## Equipment Guidelines

It is extremely important that all pupils are equipped and ready to learn, to maximise learning time in each lesson.

Every pupil must have basic equipment which includes:

- A school bag
- Pencil case for their equipment
- A number of black or blue pens
- A number of pencils
- Ruler
- Rubber
- A reading book of their choice
- Their school planner



## Non Negotiables

- No Jewellery (except a watch)
- Light makeup (no fake tan or false eyelashes)
- No piercings
- No extreme haircuts
- No acrylic nails or nail varnish
- No fizzy drinks
- No chewing gum

Mobile phones, earphones and other forms of mobile technology are not allowed to be used or visible at any time in school and are required to be kept completely out of sight until pupils leave the school site.

**Please note that staff are permitted to confiscate items of jewellery and ask pupils to remove excessive makeup which does not comply with the uniform rules.**

**Pupils planning to have their ears pierced must do so far enough in advance before starting school in September. Pupils are not permitted to wear earrings in school.**
