Dear Parent or Guardian,

Reddish Vale High School's Subjects Preferences Evening on Thursday, 19th March 2026 from 4:00 PM to 6:00 PM.

In order to support your child in transitioning into Key Stage 4 (Year 10 and 11) we will be holding a Subjects Preferences Evening for all pupils and parents/carers to attend on **Thursday, 19th March 2026 from 4:00 PM to 6:00 PM.**

During Half Term 3 your child has received information about all subjects through assemblies, they will also be undertaking options/careers activities in form time during week beginning Monday 23rd February. Pupils will also have a 1 to 1 meeting with either a member of the Senior Leadership Team or the Year 9 Pastoral Team, this will provide them with an opportunity to discuss which subjects they are considering and staff will discuss whether these are suitable subjects based on your child's current progress in this subject, what skills they have and their career aspirations.

Subjects Preferences Evening will provide you and your child with further opportunities to speak to the staff that deliver all non-Core option subjects and ask them questions about the subjects and what careers that subject would be good for. It will also provide you with an opportunity to speak to pupils who are currently doing these subjects. This is an invaluable opportunity to find out more about the courses on offer.

There will also be a number of colleges at this event who can provide you with further support as to which subjects may be more appropriate for your child to choose, in order for them to be able to progress onto the next stage of their life, once they leave school. The schools' careers advisor will also be at this event, if you or your child wishes to speak to her.

The timeline for the subject's preferences process is:

January – February 2026	Pupils has assemblies on all the option subjects on offer to them
Week beginning 24 th February 2026	Pupils undertook options/careers activities in form time
Thursday 19th March 2026	Subjects Preferences Evening
Friday 20 th – Wed 25 th March	Pupils will have a 1 to 1 meeting with a member of the Senior Leadership Team or a member of the Year 9 Pastoral Team to discuss their Preferences
