The new special edition Platinum Badge

As pupils join each level of the Rewards Club they will be given a badge which they **must** wear with pride at all times on the lapel of their blazer and a certificate that they should keep safely.



Each time they upgrade to the next level of the Rewards Club they will receive a new badge and a new certificate.

Badges & certificates will be announced and given out in assemblies.



Membership of a particular level of the Rewards Club will be dependent on pupils staying above the threshold of **RADI** points for that level.



Membership of a particular level of the Rewards Club will entitle pupils to regular privileges and include rewards such as;

- Going to the front of the dinner queue
- One-off prizes - ice cream van, breakfast etc, use of common room
- Periods off timetable for alternative activities - farm etc
- Inclusion into prize draws
- Invitations to reward events
- Reward trips
- Invitations to parental celebrations

At the end of the year, members of the Bronze, Silver or Gold clubs will be entered into a Grand Prize draw in which the winner will be able to choose between three star prizes of...

After the Grand Prize draw winner has been decided, a further 5 winners will be selected, one from each year group. These 5 winners will receive an electronic tablet

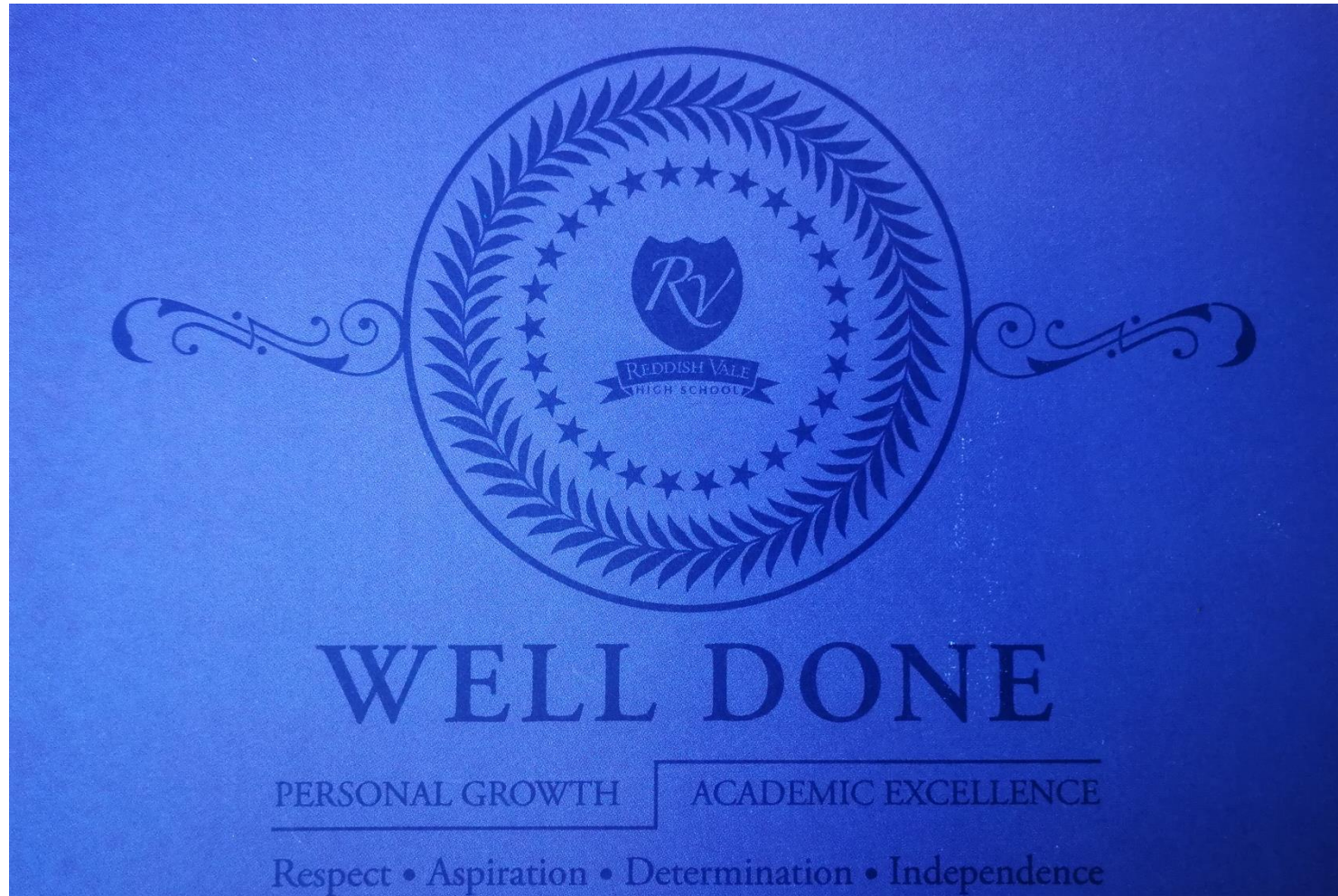


Again, Bronze club members will have a single entry, Silver club members 5 entries and Gold club members 10 entries.
