## VICTORY GARDEN

Stage 1: Lay tarpaulin to deaden grass and allow 'easy' digging



- Stage 2: Dig over and mix with manure, leave over Christmas
- Stage 3: Weed and plant good, hearty vegetables
- Stage 4: Harvest in time for VE Day celebrations!
